



Outlook 2013

Some registry changes are needed to fix a Microsoft bug, to allow IQX to access the Outlook in 'click to run' MS Office 2013.

This will need to be done by a user with **full administrative rights on the machine in question**.

Download the zip file from the link below and unpack the reg file from the zip. Then run Regedit and select the IQXOutlook2013.reg file. Note that this reg file will do the fix for both 32 & 64 bit installs. While IQX only uses 32-bit Outlook, other applications that use 64-bit Outlook may also benefit as this is a general problem!
